Call for Review Committee Candidates



Entrustable Professional Activities Committee

On behalf of the <u>Entrustable Professional Activities (EPA) Committee</u>, Chair Jitesh Patel, Vice-Chair Surya Nalamati, and ABCRS representative Glenn Ault, work is currently underway on creating three EPAs to pilot for colon and rectal surgery residents (complicated diverticulitis, perianal abscess, colonoscopy). Pilot EPAs will focus on high volume categories to allow residents/faculty multiple opportunities to complete evaluations, as well as concentrate on proficiencies that distinguish our specialty from general surgery. Our pilot is expected to be ready to introduce to all programs during our spring meeting.



Resident L-serv

During our 2022 spring meeting a discussion was held regarding creating a L-serv for our colon and rectal surgery residents, which members voted on and unanimously approved. A total of 85 residents have signed up to be part of the L-serv.

APDCRS uses the L-serv to communicate directly with residents (job offers, career course, endoscopy course, Sunday education series, APDCRS offerings, etc.). The L-serv will not be used for anything other than APDCRS business. It will not be used to solicit residents to participate in non-APDCRS sanctioned surveys / studies, etc. APDCRS controls and monitors the L-serv and each academic year we will update the L-serv with the new incoming class, and delete the old class. Program directors and education coordinators will be copied on all emails sent to the resident L-serv.
