Dr. Richard P. Billingham from Northwest Colon and Rectal Clinic (now Swedish Medical Center) in Washington was the last documented Affiliate Member accepted during the March 6 – 8, 1988 APDCRS meeting. There have been none since.

CRS Common Program Requirements Updates – Go Live 7-1-2023

Requirements Updated with Common Program Requirement Revisions

The specialty- and subspecialty-specific Program Requirements have been updated to reflect revisions to the Common Program Requirements that become effective July 1, 2023. The updated documents can be found on the Program Requirements and FAQs and Applications page of each **specialty's section** of the ACGME website, under the "Future Effective Date" header.

2024 Resident / Faculty Surveys (Change in Distribution)

Resident/Fellow and Faculty Survey Update The reporting period for the ACGME's annual surveys will open on February 13, 2023. As with last year's survey cycle, the reporting period will run for eight weeks. As the survey results are valued by programs and institutions for their continuous quality improvement efforts, further extension of the survey window could delay release of program and comparison data. The ACGME anticipates that programs will still receive their reports in early May.


The process for informing programs, faculty members, and residents/fellows of survey windows will remain unchanged from previous years. Beginning with the 2024 surveys, however, the ACGME plans to update this process and alert individuals directly about the availability of the surveys and their requested participation and deadlines. This change will be made as part of the ACGME's overall efforts toward reducing the administrative burden on designated institutional officials, program directors, and coordinators.

Core Curriculum Committee

The last time the APDCRS Core Curriculum for colon and rectal surgery programs / residents was updated was 2019. ACGME Milestones and Common Program Requirements updates were both released in 2021, necessitating a Core Curriculum update.

On behalf of the <u>Core Curriculum Committee</u> and Chair Kim Lu, the APDCRS Core Curriculum is in the final stages of being revised. Updates will be unveiled and made available to everyone during our April meeting.

- A special guest segment featuring a thought-provoking, succinct interview with an eminent Academic surgeon
- Some sessions have included live debates and future sessions will include operative video analysis

Entrustable Professional Activities Committee

On behalf of the Entrustable Professional Activities (EPA) Committee, Chair Jitesh Patel, Vice-Chair Surya Nalamati, and ABCRS representative Glenn Ault, work is currently underway on creating three EPAs to pilot for colon and rectal surgery residents (complicated diverticulitis, perianal abscess, colonoscopy). Pilot EPAs will focus on high volume categories to allow residents/faculty multiple opportunities to complete evaluations, as well as concentrate on proficiencies that distinguish our specialty from general surgery. The Committee has been meeting regularly and working closely with General Surgery EPA stakeholders. The CRS pilot is expected to be ready to introduce to all programs by the 2024 APDCRS meeting. Updates will be presented during our spring meeting.




If your resident has not signed up and would like to be part of the L-serv, please have them reach out.
